I urge you to please consider the following points for wildlife:

- ? Support a diversity of habitats for a diversity of wildlife
- ? Ensure that the following species are among those featured as focal species and species of conservation concern: Elk, Golden-Winged Warbler, Cerulean Warbler, Wood Thrush, Ruffed Grouse, White-Tailed Deer, Turkey, Black Bear, Woodcock, Trout, especially Appalachian brook trout.
- ? Ensure early succession habitat for a diversity of wildlife is included along with old growth ecosystems.
- ? Promote use of prescribed fire to establish and maintain wildlife habitat.
- ? Ensure that all habitat management tools and proper silviculture methods are available wherever the focus is on wildlife habitat management.
- ? Provide public access for hunting, fishing, back-packing, wildlife watching.
