1)I would like to see Winter trail left open to single track motorized users as I have personally ridden it for over 20 years and I recommend that another trail be developed for non-motorized users into the Wilderness trail system.

2)I would like to see Burnett Creek Trail left open for motorized use so that I and other riders may be able to purchase fuel and food in town of Rico while we are in the area. Closing this trail will also directly affect the economy of Rico. I would propose that the current trail head for Burnett Creek be moved out of the residential area of Rico and re-established West of Rico.

3)Wildcat 207 is one of the only two possible accesses south of hwy 145 from Calico trail. Safety, maintenance, food and fuel become significant issues if this trail is not available especially in the consideration of closing Burnett Creek and Horse Creek. With the quick changes in weather in the high country, exiting the area is critical for safety reasons. Single track motorized users just cannot be left with minimized exit routes for health and safety as this proposal is restructured.
