I do agree that there should be an equal amount of space available for every user group, but the areas that are more accessible for human powered travel should remain closed to motorized traffic. The motorized users can access terrain further from the roads, where the human powered personnel have a greater difficulty getting to, and it makes sense to use specific corridors to allow them access to those areas.
