In reviewing your proposed action report and map I have noted your work includes the Camp Carson Mine area and a possible interpretive site.

I strongly recommend that your activities go very slow or bypass the area in the vicinity of Camp Carson Mines.

An interpretive site anywhere in sight of the mine area would soon be wiped out by mining activity.

This property contains a two mile section of the prehistoric Carson River which contains gold and rare earth minerals.
