I have repeatedly written letters to encourage the Forest Service to look and act responsibly around the use of our trail systems for "quiet usage". Much of our economic draw into Colorado is for recreational, hunting, etc. activities and keeping this desirable for backpacking, hiking, bicycling, and hunting is of utmost concern. And this is of secondary importance to the need for assuring the habitat for wildlife migration, breeding, and foraging is maintained throughout time and all seasons. Our motorized vehicles moving into these delicate areas with special needs is something that must be mitigated with careful and deliberate management for our overall natural forest health. Bear Creek for instance, is in a unique situation where no roads access and disturb the animals' habitats and peoples' pleasure and usage. It should be completely off limits to motorized vehicles of any sort. There are hundreds and hundreds of miles of existing logging roads throughout our forests that make more sense for such activity.
