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Comments:

From a friend that said this happened the first of this month -January 2017:

In 1976, Olympic National Park was designated by UNESCO as an International Biosphere Reserve, and in 1981 as a World Heritage Site. In 1988, Congress designated 95 percent of the park as the Olympic Wilderness. I was steelhead fishing on the Hoh River up in the Park this last Sunday and the Growlers were overhead. The noise was deafening, and went on most of the day. It was like fly fishing in a war zone. I doubt seriously if this is what UNESCO or Congress had in mind with their designations of the Park as a World Biosphere Reserve, a World Heritage Site, and a protected wilderness."
