Comments:

I would like to voice my strong support of more non-motorized trails in the area being considered. I am sorry that there is not a non-motorized alternative and feel if trails are motorized they should be evaluated for impacts due to motorized travel.

Of the alternatives offered Alternative E is best, but needs modifications. The trails should include: Calico from north trail head to the junction with Priest Gulch, Rough Canyon and Bear Creek. Of these the one I use the most to hike and fish is Bear Creek where I was this morning. It already shows signs of over-use and I was dismayed to meet two motorcyclists. The quiet was broken, the fumes were unpleasant and the muddy trail was further impacted. There are places where motorized vehicles are appropriate, but single track, riparian areas in the mountains are not one of them!

On trails where it is more appropriate for motorized travel, they should be restricted to the summer season to have the least impact on wildlife.

There are so many more hikers and quiet trail users, but it seems we have so many less trails.

There are enough impacts already from horses, bikes, dogs and people and obviously not enough resources to manage what is there. More trails should be preserved for quiet use for the good of people and the health of our riparian areas and the forest in general.
