I support these segments of Alternative 5 for the protection it provides to old growth:

1. on the north end of Prince of Wales Island above the 20 Road, between the western shoreline of Red Bay and the communities of Point Baker and Port Protection;
2. on south-facing slopes below 800-feet in elevation;
3. in Dry Pass, south of Port Protection.

The Forest Service should insure:

1. the DEIS fully discloses, and provides an accurate and detailed analysis of the project's costs and benefits;
2. integration of important job-creating restoration and sustainable recreation development into all the action alternatives;
3. no use of herbicides to treat invasive plants;
4. broad protections for deer and wolf habitat recommended in the 2017 Interagency Wolf Habitat Management Program.
