1. Any Plan MUST protect the true "wilderness character" of the WSA. The FS idea of protecting the "existing character" is neither satisfactory nor sufficient
 2. The wilderness character must be ensured for the future by classifying ALL of the lands as having the "Primitive standard", the highest possible FS designation!
 3. The lands within the WSA purchased by the federal government in response to the Exxon Valdez spill must receive the strongest possible protection to ensure their wilderness values remain for "perpetuity for conservation and wilderness purposes", those values for which the lands were purchased to begin with.
 4. The continued illegal recreational uses of chainsaws in the WSA must end and end now, and the prohibitions against their use must be strictly enforced.
 5. And, finally, Alternative D must be expanded to include the Lake Nellie Juan and associated lands purchased for restoration following Exxon Valdez.
