Please open more snowmachine access into the Chugach National Forest and by all means do not restrict access to motorized users. I've enjoyed hiking and fishing around Tatitlek as well. I strongly opposed losing any snowmachine access on the Kenai Peninsula and thus alternatives C and D are unacceptable. With how quiet and fuel efficient today's snowmachines are, more access needs to be opened up in lower elevations so that families like mine can recreate.

We have been having low snow years the last few winters and I feel that snowmachine access trails too often are closed. The EIS/Forest plan does not bring solutions forward to address this issue for trails to remain open for us to enjoy the back country.

Please do not add any more acres to the Wilderness plan, this only blocks access from Alaskans who enjoy the land to recreate. I strongly urge that there be no more Wilderness designated land. In conclusion I ask that you allow motorized users like myself and family more access to the land we enjoy and love.
