Thank you for taking action to protect our motorized access in the Chugach! You are almost done!

My name is Corey Boyd.

First off, thank you for your efforts and willingness to include all user groups in the Chugach Forest Service Revision Plan.

I currently live in North Pole, AK, and have been living in Alaska for 35 years. I have enjoyed riding snowmachines in the Chugach for 20 years, and I typically go 15 times a year. As a motorized user, I oppose losing any right to motorized access of these public lands. A large majority of the Chugach is already restricted to non-motorized use, and what's left shall remain intact, if not expanded, for future generations.

The areas I access the forest are: Summit Lake, Turnagain, Johnson Pass

The rights of motorized user groups have diminished since 2002 when The National Forest Service initiated the Forest Land Management Plan and it must stop.

Please consider leaving the current access in place and work toward opening more areas for future generations.
