It is my understanding that there review under way for the Salmon-Challis National Forest in Idaho, and that recommendation is in the work that certain areas be designated as wilderness, with consequent closures of established access roads for motorized vehicles. I urge that every effort be made to accommodate established access paths and to not work to prohibit the public from fair use, such as hunting, non-impactful recreation, etc. and which contribute to the Idaho economy. I do not live in Idaho, but on two occasions I have visited King Mountain in Moore Idaho to observe and participate in hangliding and paragliding activities. These extremely non-impactful foot launched sports in particular require continued access on established drive access roads to mountain launch sites. It is in the public interest, and in the interest of Idaho and the local economy, that access to sites such as the drive up to King Mountain not be blocked as part of any reclassification of land use for the Salmon-Challis National Forest area.
