I wanted to weigh in regarding the value of King Mountain as a flying site for hang gliders and paragliders. This includes road access to King Mountain launch and the airspace above the surrounding areas, including the Lost River and the Lemhi Range. Paragliding is a low impact activity that relies on access to sites like King in order to enjoy.

Designating it as a wilderness area without a waiver for paragliding/hang gliding activities would cause some of the lowest impact users (can't leave footprints on the sky!) to be denied access to this extraordinary area.

Please consider leaving King Mountain as an area with designated access points for us free flight pilots.
