Comments:

I am a resident of Southeast Alaska and have spent time on and around Prince of Wales Island, most recently on a three-week kayaking trip last August, based from Craig.

I am concerned that the "Out-year Plan" does not disclose site-specific details; I am unable to make specific comments, not knowing the locations of proposed roads and timber harvests.

Absent location-specific information, I can only comment that Prince of Wales Island has already lost too much old-growth habitat, with attendant impacts on tourism, subsistence, recreation, hunting, and subsistence.

It appears the proposed actions focus on timber harvest, rather than balancing resource extraction with watershed improvement and restoration projects. Planning and funding should be re-balanced to prioritize the latter.
