They can carry an approx. 60lb. load to enable hikers to neatly and effortlessly carry their items which encourages responsible use of our forest land. They have helped the forest service by carrying communication equipment into the mountainous areas in New Mexico and Colorado during forest fires. Llamas have been used in Search & Rescue missions when horses and four-wheelers can't do the job.
