Many species of wildlife require habitat featuring secondary succession. Old growth forests do not typically provide this needed habitat. Forest management practices should encourage secondary succession by conducting timber harvests where environmentally suitable. A mixture of old growth forests and a patchwork of small clear cuts of varying ages would benefit many species of wildlife including grouse, wild turkey, whitetail deer.
