A few years ago when Patterson Creek was scheduled for decommissioning I offered Mr Gardner viable options to keep that road opened as a co-trail. I even had a sizeable group of volunteers prepared to maintain the trail. After going through the process for one and a half years, I basically got a pat on the head and participation trophy. In other words,thanks for playing but his (Mr.Gardner)was already made up. Only through support from Congressman Tom Graves office was I able to stall the process.
