I support the project and would like to see more relocations of "legacy" trails and or new trail construction along the Tillman Road Corridor. We need more trails and better trail connectivity in the North River District of the George Washington National Forest, and this project will help with that.

The Narrowback Mountain trail system is important for intermediate and beginner trail visitors vs. other more challenging trails in the Forest.

Constructing more trails close to the Forest boundary will help cut down on drive time.
