My 4 objections to your final plan point out where I think you can make important improvements:

1. The plan fails to manage lands that have wilderness characteristics as wilderness, or in a way that preserves that potential. Once lost it'll be gone FOREVER.
2. Mechanized use outside the current areas in the Crazy Mt.s backcountry will undoubtedly cause unwanted habitat degradation & increase user conflict.
3. The proposed size of backcountry in the Crazie's is crazy given the current inventoried roadless area & should be managed with its current wild state.
4. Grizzly bear habitat needs a larger recovery zone of protection for successful recovery management! Our CGNF is crucial as a corridor from the Greater Yellowstone to the continental divide ecosystem & its bear populations.
