The economic vitality of the Teton Valley is highly dependent on revenue from tourism, and Grand Targhee Resort (GTR) is one of the main drivers of tourism revenue in the valley.

GTR is a great, little resort but, unfortunately, it is hugely overshadowed by the amenities and capacity of most other western ski resorts and as such has a difficult time competing for those valuable tourism dollars. Without a major expansion, there is significant concern that GTR will be forced to shut down; taking with it the jobs, tax revenue and recreation opportunities with it. This, in turn, would cause irreparable economic harm to the region.
