The Great American Outdoors Act provides funding for the Forest Service to "address deferred maintenance and other infrastructure projects on national forests and grasslands through 2025.

I support the general purpose of these funds. However, there are a few details that deserve your attention. Funds for major maintenance on roads on the Chattahoochee NF should go where public access is needed the most and funding is least available, NOT where funding will already be available in conjunction with the Foothills Landscape Project.

There are many problem roads better suited for this type of funding.

Access roads within the Foothills Landscape are less likely to need major repairs compared to the higher elevations with steeper slopes and higher rainfall.
