I am writing in support of this project addressing infrastructure needs in our Chattahoochee-Oconee National Forests, and want to draw particular attention to a concern that these funds should be spent on roads where public access is MOST needed and where alternate funding sources are unavailable.

We know road maintenance is critical in the forest as issues with erosion compromise water quality, especially at higher elevations/slopes. I want to voice my particular concern that funds not be applied where funding may already be available, specifically for sites connected to the Foothills Landscape Project.

I hope the Forest Service will be able to use funds to address problem roads that urgently need this funding and that are a source of environmental damage in our National Forests. I am grateful for all the work that goes on to make our forests accessible, and appreciate the particular attention to making sure these roads are well-maintained and not a source of ongoing harm to our precious public resources.
